As you will be aware residential trips have been booked for our Years 3 – 6 for 2012. In our programme of residentials for next year Ghyll Head does not feature for any year due to the one off London trip we have planned for year 6.

We have however been lucky enough to secure one weekend at Ghyll Head next year for 15.6.12 – 17.6.12.

We have been given the house and bungalow for the weekend but that does only give us 52 places maximum.

Ghyll Head is a large country house set in seventeen acres of its own grounds, with extensive views of Coniston and Langdale Fells. It is situated on the east side of Lake Windermere, about three miles south of Bowness.

We have been visiting Ghyll Head each year since 2006 and it is a weekend all children have enjoyed.

The cost of this trip is £ 130.00 which includes coach travel, accommodation, meals, insurance and all activities.

The activities your child may be doing are hill walking, gill scrambling, orienteering, rope course, problem solving, rock climbing, caving, zip wire, canoeing, raft building etc.

This is an open weekend we have managed to secure.

If you would like your child to have the opportunity to go to Ghyll Head please complete the attached form and return it to School by Monday 19th September 2011 with your £25.00 deposit.

Please note there are only 52 places available and once these have been filled we cannot take any more next year to Ghyll Head.
