Over many years the Friends of Beaver Road worked on behalf of the School to raise money for projects. Just two weeks ago FOBR contributed £7000 (the last of their funds) towards the new School Library which will open in January.

Last summer some of the stalwarts of FOBR had decided it was time for them to hand over to a new generation of parents and carers.

The idea for the Christmas Fair was put forward by Nabila Din who had helped to organise the Eid ul Fitr celebrations for children earlier in the term. It was a joint parents and staff initiative.

The principle aim of the Christmas Fair was to organise a social event for all our families to enjoy. We have a wonderfully vibrant multicultural school community to be proud of.

Any money raised would go towards the building and furnishing of a multi-use Community Room in the School (a conversion of a former cloakroom area).

Fundraising is really important to our School. We are the lowest funded school in Manchester on an amount per pupil comparison. Fundraising helps us provide improvements to our school building (now nearly 80 years old) and grounds that enhance every child's school experience.

We are interested in building on the success of the Christmas Fair.

In the New Year we will be calling a meeting of parents, carers and staff to consider what events we might organise in the future.
