

How did Britain change between the end of the Iron Age and the end of the Roman occupation?

Spellings: these are updated every Friday on EdShed, where you will find lots of fun activities to help you practice.

Mangahigh: you will be assigned a weekly Mangahigh activity linked to our Maths learning.

Times Tables Rock Stars: work on improving your *Soundcheck* score to develop quick recall of all 12x12 facts.

Lexia: available at home if your child has access to this in school.

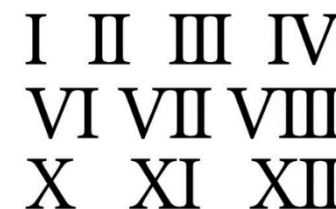


Oxford Reading Buddy



Maths
