Dear Parents and Carers,

As we prepare for transition of the children from their current year group to their new one in September, we are pleased to inform you about the year group teaching teams and class allocations for next year. Please see the tables below for information about your child's class teacher and year group teaching teams from September 2023.

Wednesday 5th July is our whole school transition day. This is a great opportunity for your child to meet their new class teacher for September and spend the day familiarising themselves with their new environment.

On Wednesday 5th July in the morning, our children currently in Reception to Year 6 will register with their current classrooms before being taken to the classroom they will be in next year. This is with the exception of our Year 3 children, who will need to come to the Junior School in the morning for 8.30am. Those Year 3 children who normally attend breakfast club will be walked over from the First School to the Junior School by the breakfast club team ready for registration.

The children will spend the whole day in their new classroom and will be dismissed at the end of the day by their new class teacher from their new class exit. Please note, the First School will still finish at 3.20pm and the Junior School will finish at 3.00pm. Please see the table below, so you know which door your child will be dismissed from. Those children in Year 3 who would normally attend After School Club at the First School will be able to attend After School Club at the Junior school.

On transition day, other teachers who are not involved in transition day will teach our current Year 6 children.

At the end of transition day, you will have the opportunity to meet your child's new teacher at the new exit where you will collect your child next year. For parents and carers of Year 3 children moving to Year 4 at the Junior School, you are also invited into the Junior School for a tour at the end of transition day.

There are a few changes in our staffing to highlight from September 2023....

Due to our expanding 5-form entry school reaching Year 5 this September and our pupil numbers exceeding 1000, the staffing structure of our school has been revised. This is to ensure that from September, we are able to meet capacity needs across both school sites. Together with our Governors and Trustees, we are delighted to introduce some temporary leadership roles as well as new teaching posts.

- In September, Mrs Byrne and Mr Davenport will take up the role of Head of School and will be based on one school site each half term. To start the year, Mrs Byrne will be Head of the First School and Mr Davenport will be Head of the Junior School. They will continue to lead the school together with me throughout the year and work flexibly as needed across both school sites.
- In September, Mrs Mour and Mrs Reding will take up the role of Assistant Head of School. They will both continue to be head of their respective year groups and will teach their class on a part time basis alongside another experienced teacher as a job share. This will enable them to have 2 days each week to carry out their Assistant Head of School leadership role and responsibilities.
- As a result of the continued expansion, we have some additional teacher positions that we have appointed teachers to, as well as a new approach to how we organise teachers planning, preparation and assessment time to ensure that all of the curriculum time is more balanced, sequenced and consistent.

We sadly say goodbye this year to Mrs Turvey (Miss Turner), one of our Head of Years and Miss Holbach, one of our Year 4 class teachers. They are both moving to new roles in different local authorities. We are also saying goodbye to four of our teaching assistants: Miss Sumner and Miss Novak, who have both made the decision to retire after many successful years working at Beaver Road. Miss Deering in Reception is also leaving due to recently getting married and moving to Liverpool this Summer and Miss Puddephatt in Year 1 is moving on to become a theatre set designer. We thank them for all their contributions over the years they have been with us and wish them all the very best for the future.

We are thrilled that both Mrs Rogers and Miss Holmes will be returning to the leadership team as Head of Year 5 and Head of Nursery respectively in September. We are also pleased to welcome back Miss Toolan-Kerr from her gap year travelling.

In addition, we are delighted to welcome some talented and experienced new teachers to our team.


