Dear Parents and Carers,

As we prepare for transition of the children from their current year group to their new one in September, we are pleased to inform you about the year group teaching teams and class allocations for next year. Please see the tables below for information about your child's class teacher and year group teaching teams from September 2021. There are teaching assistant interviews taking place next week for the vacancies in the identified year groups. We will communicate with you about who has been appointed to these roles as soon as possible.

As part of our transition arrangements this year, there will be transition booklets introducing you to your child's new teacher and organisational matters relating to your child's new year group. These will be circulated to you next Wednesday and will also be available on your child's current year group page under 'files to download'.

Due to the current rise of Covid-19 cases in our school community, we have had to reconsider the organisation of transition day on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July. In order to ensure the safest environment possible in school, unfortunately children will not be moving to their new class environment on this day. Instead, your child's new teacher will visit your child's current classroom. The teachers will wear a face covering and remain as socially distanced as possible. All teaching assistants will stay within their current classes.

As a result of these changes and in order to introduce new staff joining our teaching team to parents and carers, each year group will share a short film of the year group team and environment the children are moving to. These will be shared with the children and also made available on our school website under our school tour page (at the top left of the website) from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

Depending on the Covid-19 regulations and guidance in place for schools from September 2021, we hope to plan an opportunity as soon as possible to welcome parents and carers back into our school environment and to meet your child's new teacher in person.
