Welcome back to the second half of Autumn term. We launched our new learning challenge of 'What are the main features of the UK?' with an exciting challenge to build the tallest tower with spaghetti and marshmallows - we clearly have some future engineers in the making! Our focus in Science will be 'Living things and their habitats'.





English

This term, our first literacy unit is based around a suspense story called The Abandoned City, where we will learn how to draw on a range of tools to build suspense such as the use of personification to describe the weather. Our non-fiction text will focus on a writing a balanced argument to debate different views.

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on: multiplication and division. We will be exploring multiplying by different numbers before looking at written methods to multiply 2-digit numbers (with and without renaming) and then dividing 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. Remember that your homework on Mangahigh will support our learning in school and use of TTRS will help develop quick recall of multiplication facts.

Reading at Home

Your child should be reading their colour banded book at home for 10-15 minutes each day. We expect to see a Seesaw post at least 3 times a week with a picture of the book. This year, we are also introducing **Book Talk** sessions every **Friday**, where children will be discussing the book they are currently reading with their peers in class. As such, it is important that your child has their **reading book in school every Friday**. This will help us track and monitor reading in school. Remember your child can still change their books every day in class.

Your child will be set a weekly spelling list at 3pm on EdShed each Friday and will complete a dictation assessment on Friday the following week. **MANGAHIGH**


