Dear Parents and Carers,

As we prepare for transition of the children from their current year group to their new one in September, we are pleased to inform you about the year group teaching teams and class allocations for next year. Please see the tables below for information about your child's class teacher and year group teaching teams from September 2024.

Wednesday 3rd July is our whole school transition day. This is a great opportunity for your child to meet their new class teacher for September and spend the day familiarising themselves with their new environment.

On Wednesday 3rd July in the morning, our children currently in Reception to Year 6 will register with their current classrooms before being taken to the classroom they will be in next year. This is with the exception of our Year 3 children, who will need to come to the Junior School in the morning for 8.30am. Those Year 3 children who normally attend breakfast club will be walked over from the First School to the Junior School by the breakfast club team ready for registration.

The children will spend the whole day in their new classroom and will be dismissed at the end of the day by their new class teacher from their new class exit. Please note, the First School will still finish at 3.20pm and the Junior School will finish at 3.00pm. Please see the table below, so you know which door your child will be dismissed from. Those children in Year 3 who would normally attend After School Club at the First School will be able to attend After School Club at the Junior school.

On transition day, other teachers who are not involved in transition day will teach our current Year 6 children.

At the end of transition day, you will have the opportunity to meet your child's new teacher at the new exit where you will collect your child next year. For parents and carers of Year 3 children moving to Year 4 at the Junior School, you are also invited into the Junior School for a tour at the end of transition day.

There are a few changes in our staffing to highlight from September 2024....

Following a review of our staffing structure this year with Trustees and Governors, we are delighted to let you know about some permanent changes to our staffing arrangements, which will take effect from this September.

- Mr Davenport has been appointed as the permanent Head of School for the whole school. From September, he will continue to lead the school together with me as Executive Headteacher. We will we work flexibly as needed across both school sites with Ms Byrne, who will be resuming her role as Deputy Head for the whole school.
- Mrs Mour and Mrs Reding will continue in their roles as Assistant Head of School, which have now been made permanent positions. They will both continue to be head of their respective year groups and will teach their class on a part time basis alongside another experienced teacher as a job share. This will enable them to have 2.5 days each week to carry out their Assistant Head of School leadership role and responsibilities.
- As a result of the continued expansion (which will reach Year 6 this year), as well as a few staff changes, we have some new teachers joining our team who we look forward to welcoming to Beaver Road this September. We also have some changes next year to the PPA teaching team (who cover teachers planning, preparation and assessment time each week), which will be temporarily led this year by Mr London.
- With Mr London's change in role, Mrs Horan has been appointed temporarily as Head of Year for Reception next year.

We are sadly saying goodbye to Mrs Kershaw who has dedicated over 20 years of her teaching career to Beaver Road and will be retiring at the end of this academic year. Mrs Kershaw's commitment, excellent teaching, care and passion for the important role she has had within the school will no doubt have a lasting impact on the thousands of lives she has so positively influenced over the years. We send her our thanks and wish her a long and happy retirement.

Mr Whyte (Year 4 teacher) and Mrs Baker (Year 3 teaching assistant) will also be leaving us at the end of this academic year to explore new career opportunities. Mr Reed (Year 2 teacher) will temporarily be leaving us to enjoy a gap year in Australia and we look forward to welcoming him back in September 2025. We thank them for all of their contributions over the time they have been with us and wish them all the best for their new adventures.
