

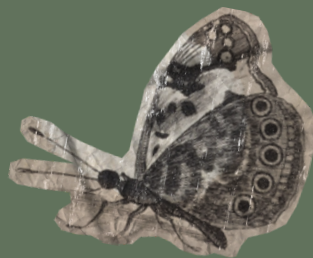


## Hello, I'm Miss Holmes!
