Wednesday 30th October 2024

As part of our History topic about The Great Fire of London, Year 2 will be going on a trip to **Staircase House in December**. Staircase house is Stockport's oldest town house and it will give the children an opportunity to learn about how our ancestors lived in the period around the Great Fire of London. There will be role play opportunities, they'll get to learn about what Samuel Pepys wrote in his eye witness diary and there will also be some fun, practical activities.



To accommodate our full year group, the trip will be split across a number of days:

- **2M and 2BM** will be going on **Monday 2nd December 2024**
- **2B** will be going on **Friday 6th December 2024**
- **2LM and 2C** will be going on **Tuesday 10th December 2024**

All Year 2 classes will leave for the trip on a coach straight after drop off and will be back in time for home time at 3.20pm. Children will be expected to wear school uniform as normal. If your child usually has a paid school meal, we will provide a packed lunch. Please complete the survey on the School Spider App, where you can choose which packed lunch option you wish your child to have. This survey will be made live on **1st November 2024** and will close at the end of the school day on **18th November 2024**. You may wish to provide your child with a packed lunch from home. Please could you navigate to your account on the School Spider App to make a voluntary contribution of **£17.00**. This covers the cost of the educational trip, workshops and coach travel. In the case of pupils whose parents feel they are unable to contribute, please contact the School Office in the first instance. In line with our Pupil Premium promise, children who are in receipt of Free School Meals and qualify as Pupil Premium are entitled to free school trips.
