Dear Parents and Carers of Year 5,

It is with regret that I am writing to inform you that the residential visit to Peat Rigg this week is unable to go ahead. We have been keeping up to date with all the latest advice from the Government and Public Heath England over the last few weeks. However, following the latest announcements from the Government and national guidance yesterday about non-essential travel and other recommendations about social contact, this visit cannot go ahead.

We are unsure at this stage whether it is possible to rearrange this visit, but it is looking unlikely due to Peat Rigg being fully booked for the rest of the school year. You will receive a full refund for the amounts you have paid to school for the visit. These refunds will be made once the insurance claim has been processed, but at this stage, we are not sure how long this will take. We will let you know as soon as possible.

These are unprecedented times, but please be assured that we are all working together in the best interests of the whole school community, and we continue to follow all the updated instructions and advice from the DFE and Public Health England.
