


Dear Parent/Carers,

We are delighted to celebrate the 25th anniversary of World Book Day on **Thursday 3rd March 2022**. As Year 4 will be on their residential visit to Robinwood on this day, children in **Year 4 will have an alternate date** for World Book Day on **Tuesday 1st March 2022**.
