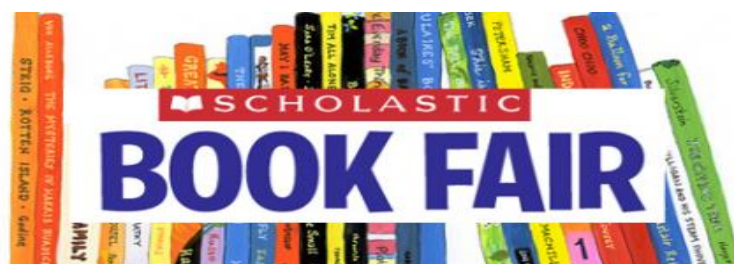

Payments:


