Many thanks to the majority of you who have taken the time to complete our short survey. Overall, the survey has shown us that 68% of parents/carers who completed it, said they would be sending their children back to school from the 1st June, subject to health and safety procedures being in place.

If the government goes ahead with the plan to reopen schools from the 1st June, we have now developed a safe phased reopening plan based on this and your responses. If you said you did not want your child to return yet and you change your mind at any time, please let us know. We have still prepared a place for your child (in the identified year groups) if you decide you would like them to attend school.

We are able to confirm the return dates below for each year group. Please be aware that we are still working on the detailed practicalities that you will need to know before your child returns to school, including details of which 'bubble' your child will be in and which school entrances etc. Therefore, we will send this detailed information as soon as it is available next week (during half term). If the government change the date to reopen, we will revise the dates on our plan and inform you as soon as possible. In this circumstance, our keyworker provision will continue to go ahead.

(except for Key Worker children) Due to the high number of children returning, unfortunately we do not have the appropriate learning environment space or staffing to accommodate 16 Early Years 'bubbles'. Therefore, we are in a position currently where we are only able to offer provision to children on a biweekly basis. The 'bubble' your child is in, including the weeks your child will be in school, will be sent to you next week.

We hope to be able to answer more of your detailed questions next week (over half term) when we send more information that is specific about your child's return.

The staff team and I really look forward to welcoming the children back to school from the 1st June, and although it will not be like school any of us have known before, we will still have fun and enjoy the time we have back together.
