



We have provided a document that is intended to support your child with their transition into reception, with the focus being around personal, social and emotional development as this is an extremely significant area to support them in their transition into Reception. Please use as you feel best, there is no pressure to complete all the activities.

At Beaver Road, we normally offer a school tour with food tasting from our marvellous chef Martin, time in class with the teacher for parents and children and home visits for new to school children. Due to COVID-19, our new current Health and Safety procedures mean that this is not possible. However, we can assure you that we will do all we can to give your child the best possible transition. We will begin by hosting an information meeting via Zoom for all families who are coming to Beaver Road Reception in September on Thursday June 18th at 16.00 and 18.30. Due to restrictions on the number of participants we can have on Zoom, we can only accommodate one email account per household and need to host two meetings. You will be allocated your time slot in our next communication.



Please note that at this stage we are not sure if all children will be able to return to school in September full time. We are currently waiting for further advice and guidance from the DFE and the City Council regarding school opening and organisation from September. We will inform parents and carers as soon as we know what our plans will be.
