Dear Parents and Carers,

As we prepare for transition of the children from their current year group to their new one in September, we are pleased to inform you about the year group teaching teams and class allocations for next year. Please see the tables below for information about your child's class teacher and year group teaching teams from September 2022. There are teaching assistant adverts and interviews taking place later this term for the vacancies in the identified year groups. We will communicate with you about who has been appointed to these roles as soon as possible.

Wednesday 6th July is our whole school transition day. This is a great opportunity for your child to meet their new class teacher for September and spend the day familiarising themselves with their new environment.

On Wednesday 6th July in the morning, our children currently in Reception to Year 6 will register with their current class teacher in their usual classrooms before being taken to the classroom they will be in next year. This is with the exception of our Year 3 children, who will need to come to the Junior School in the morning for 8.30AM. Those Year 3 children who normally attend breakfast club will be walked over from the First School to the Junior building by Miss Zealey and Miss Lynas ready for registration.

The children will spend the whole day in their new classroom and will be dismissed at the end of the day by their new class teacher from their new class exit. Please note, the First School will still finish at 3.20PM and the Junior School will finish at 3.00PM. Please see the table below, so you know which door your child will be dismissed from. Those children in Year 3 who would normally attend After School Club at the First School will be able to attend After School Club at the Junior school.

Our current Year 6 children will be taught by our PPA team on transition day.

At the end of transition day, you will have the opportunity to meet your child's new teacher at the new exit where you will collect your child next year. For parents and carers of Year 3 children moving to Year 4 at the Junior School, you are also invited into the Junior School for a tour at the end of transition day.



Miss Bradley-Newby (who has been a TA in Nursery this year) will join our teaching team in Year 3 as an Early Career Teacher, and Miss Holdbach (who has been a student teacher with us this year) will join our teaching team in Year 4 as an Early Career Teacher.
