Dear Parents and Carers of children in Year 4,

As part of the Music provision and curriculum here at Beaver Road, all children have the opportunity to learn a musical instrument. Recorder lessons are due to start in Year 4 on **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020**. These lessons will run every Thursday morning and be delivered by Xina Lodge, an instrumental teacher from One Education's Music Service.

There are a number of recorders available in school for your child to use for these lessons. However, these instruments must remain in school at all times. If you would like the school to order your child a recorder, so that they can continue to practice and showcase their learning at home, please make a payment of £10.00 on ParentPay. Alternatively if you would like to buy your own, the school will be using Yamaha descant recorders which are widely available online and in most instrumental shops.

Please ensure your child has their recorders available on the day of their lessons and that these are labelled with your child's name and class. School cannot take responsibility for any recorders that go missing and/or are damaged.

These instrumental lessons will be conducted in accordance with Government guidelines around COVID-19 and all relevant risk assessments have been carried out. In line with this guidance, there will be no sharing of recorders.
